

# KALAELOA CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Work is underway at a nearly eight-acre site along Bougainville Avenue and Nassau Street. The parcel was graded and improved with recycled asphalt last year. This summer, crews will widen the drainage basins and pave the site to prepare it for Servco to use as a vehicle processing center later this summer. Hunt is working with the State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) and Honua Consulting to ensure that areas of cultural significance, including burial sites, are identified, respected, and protected.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to create the foundation for the future of Kalaeloa. Our top priorities during construction are to complete these necessary improvements as efficiently as possible while providing safe access in and around Kalaeloa with minimal interruption.
